Jeanneau Yachts 57 'Mojito' is now for sale exclusively with YOTI in Manly, Queensland, Australia.

A proven offshore cruiser that blends performance, comfort, and ease of handling, the Jeanneau Yachts 57 is one of Jeanneau's most successful large cruising designs. Designed by Philippe Briand, she delivers impressive sailing performance alongside a practical, well-resolved layout, equally suited to passage making and extended liveboard cruising.

'Mojito' (2015) is a well-maintained and extensively upgraded example, with major systems renewed in recent years. Highlights include a new engine and generator package, updated rigging, a full Raymarine navigation suite, and Starlink connectivity—making her a highly capable, turn-key cruising yacht.

The highly desirable three-cabin owner's layout features a full-beam aft master suite with private ensuite and seating area, complemented by two forward double cabins, each with its own bathroom. The saloon is bright and welcoming, with a large convertible settee, a spacious and well-appointed galley, and excellent storage throughout. The overall layout strikes a smart balance between comfort at anchor and practicality at sea.

On deck, the twin-helm cockpit provides excellent visibility and control, with all sail handling led aft for safe and efficient short-handed sailing. Her cutter rig, in-mast furling mainsail, and electric winches are key features that make the Jeanneau 57 such a manageable yacht in this size range.

'Mojito' has benefited from a comprehensive upgrade program focused on reliability, comfort, and ease of use, including:

Mechanical & Power: New Yanmar 150hp engine (2022), Onan 11kW generator (2022)

Electronics & Navigation: Full Raymarine suite (2022), including Axiom XL 16", AIS and autopilot; Starlink (2024)

Systems & Comfort: Watermaker serviced with new membrane (2025), induction cooktop and oven (2024), new house and start batteries (2024) with monitoring system

She is exceptionally well-equipped for comfortable cruising, with multi-zone air conditioning, generous refrigeration, a watermaker, a generator, and a well-configured electrical system.
