This Lagoon SEVENTY8 was commissioned by a very experienced Australian family who have previously commissioned one of the world's most successful 56M Super Yachts. With a staggering 4000nm range and carrying 8500L of fuel, this Catamaran is perfect for stable, safe and luxurious bluewater exploration. A fully crewed and professionally managed vessel from launch, GBS has had no expense spared in her commissioning and ongoing upgrades and management.

Production took place at CNB Lagoon, Bordeaux, the world leader in catamaran production with molding and completion taking place in the new purpose-built facility. In October 2017 she was pre-commissioned in France, before final commissioning took place and she was handed over in Sydney, Australia in January 2018.

Her very complete galley is aft and to port and allows good separation from the saloon. Conveniently located just forward of the galley are very comfortable crew quarters with ensuite coupling as a day head. The forward port cabin is very comfortable with good sized ensuite and separate shower.

The saloon is palatial with large dinette to port and very comfortable saloon lounge mid-ships and to starboard. The sunken lounge area forward and to starboard allows good separation from the rest of the saloon. An island in the forward saloon houses drink fridges and glass wear and on the port side are two very visible B&G touchscreens.

The starboard hull is all accommodation. Her VIP guest cabin with ensuite is exclusively accessed and in the aft section of the hull. In the starboard hull forward is the ultimate owner's cabin. Looking forward from her incredible ensuite is an owner's desk inboard and chaise directly outboard. Beyond her massive island berth as a separate walk in wardrobe with closing screen.

In both bows are additional crew or guest accommodation.

The flybridge is incredible. A complete wet bar is at the top of the stairs and to port and forward. The steering station is forward and mid ships and starboard are two cocktail tables that can be converted to one formal dining table. There is a massive daybed for lounging across the entire beam of the
